APPRENTICESHIPS

- Four high school and college students (age 16+) will be selected by audition to be "Roots" Apprentices for the 2022-23 season.
- Each student will receive \$300 paid in two \$150 installments in December and April, depending on participation/attendance

BENEFITS ALSO INCLUDE

- Coverage of dues for the season (\$100)
- Music for rehearsals and concerts loaned for season (refundable \$25 deposit required)
- Concert attire furnished (\$100-plus value)
- Full participation in all Milwaukee Choristers' activities
- Opportunity to study and sing a varied repertoire of quality music under the direction of Music Director Dr. James B. Kinchen, Jr.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Member in good standing of an area high school or college/university choir
- High school students must be at least 16 years old and have their school director's permission
- Must sing an audition for the music director
- Must show musical/vocal talent, strong choral music interest, and promise of future success in community choral arts
