## APPRENTICESHIPS

- High school & college students (age 16+) are selected by audition each season to become "Roots" Apprentices. Apprentices may sing for one or more semesters (preferably a full season) at the music director's discretion.
- Each student will receive \$350 per semester (\$700 per season), depending on participation/attendance. Concerts are held in December and April.

- Loaned music for rehearsals and concerts.
